- Discussion included opposition from Sorors Newman, Daniels, and Gipson. Comments included that the change would not allow sufficient time to prepare the required reports for the chapter meeting. Soror Newman also stated that the agenda section of "New Business" is designated for any items that were not presented in the preceding Eboard. Soror Lagrone-Haynes spoke in favor.
- <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: Move that the Executive Board meetings be held on the Tuesday prior to the monthly chapter meeting. The motion was properly made, seconded, voted, and did NOT pass with a vote of 6-14.



#### Community Invitations & Request

#### Alpha Phi Alpha

- Alpha Phi Alpha has requested AAC support of purchasing a full page ad at the cost of \$150 plus purchase two tickets- one for the AAC Chapter President plus one delegate-for \$125 each. The total request is \$400.
- The request was received during the summer. The event is to be held Sep 17, 2022. Discussion included comments that the Alpha Phi Alpha organization has supported AAC in the past.
- In response to a request about the line item budget, there is \$300 set aside for this item; making the line item budget \$100 short of the request. Soror Jeffrey Archer voiced that she was in support of the request and that she would make up the \$100 difference if necessary.
- <u>RECOMMENDATION</u> Move that AAC support the Alpha Phi Alpha organization by purchasing a full-page ad for \$150 and two tickets at \$125 each for their upcoming gala. The motion was properly made, seconded, voted upon, and passed with a vote of 16-6.
- <u>RECOMMENDATION</u> Move that \$100 be moved from contingency to cover the Alpha Phi Alpha \$400 request. The current line item is \$300 and the request totals \$400. The difference of \$100 is needed from contingency. The motion was properly made, seconded, voted upon, and passed with a vote of 17-2.

#### Jamaica Chapter-DST

- The Jamaica Chapter Sisterhood Retreat is to be held Oct 13-15, 2022. The retreat will include self-care, sisterhood fellowship, and learning. Speakers include the immediate Past National President Soror Beverly Smith, Emmy-nominated actress Soror Sheryl Lee Ralph, and author of *In Search of Sisterhood* Soror Paula Giddings
- Opportunity to connect with the Jamaica chapter in the spirit of International Awareness.
- Discussion included opposition from Sorors Newman and Gipson. Soror Newman commented that there is so much to do especially since there is now a new Regional Director and Regional Representative. Soror Gipson expressed general opposition unless the International Awareness committee already had sufficient funding in its budget for the purpose.
- The cost is including registration, hotel, air transportation is \$1,680.
- <u>RECOMMENDATION</u> Move that Austin Alumnae send one (1) International Awareness Committee Chair member to the Jamaica Chapter Sisterhood Retreat on Oct 13-15, 2022. The cost is estimated at \$1,680. The motion was properly made, seconded, voted upon, and did NOT pass with a vote of 2-21.
