• The October chapter meeting was virtual, so the standard emergency exits message was not issued.





Budget Highlights

- The 2022-2023 Budget assumed 230 members.
- Budget and Finance Budget Adjustments
 - o \$2,650 for Education Development: (\$2,000 College Tour, \$200 GEMS, \$200 Academy, \$250 EMBODI)
 - o \$500 for Charitable Partners: (\$500 American Heart Association
 - o \$500 for the Certified Public Account Audit
 - o \$75 for the PO BOX
 - o \$1,500 for Heritage and Archives (Cost of preserving historical items in a climate-controlled environment)
 - o \$250 for Chapter photo
 - o \$1000 for Founders' Day
 - o \$200 for Local Courtesies
 - o \$2021 for Technology Zoom and Mailchimp costs
 - o \$125 for Greek Letter organization
 - o \$384 remaining to Contingency
- <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: B & F Committee recommends approval of the budget adjustments as outlined above. The

Rules

- All information on the region's or chapter's website must be REVIEWED and APPPROVED by the regional director or chapter president
- All social media accounts or pages MUST BE PUBLIC.
- Profanity filters must be turned on.
- Chapters MAY NOT EARN REVENUE from the social media account
- Only administrators may create posts
- Anyone may comment on a post, BUT a member of the region leadership MUST MONITOR REGULARLY and remove inappropriate content
- FOR SECURITY PURPOSES, DO NOT show location UNLESS it is a promotional post.

What to remember

- Protect Delta's confidentiality and proprietary information
- Delta's Code of Conduct applies to both online and offline activities
- Treat all persons with dignity and respect
- Do not misuse Delta's intellectual property i.e. name, logo, symbols
- Do not edit official Delta's social media posts prior to sharing






- Those who wish to speak must sign a form provided at the meeting location one hour before the meeting


