- Short Year (to complete the 2023 Calendar Year) Jul Dec 31, 2023
  - Payable Jan 1 Mar 31, 2023: \$92.50
  - \$92.50 represents one half of the local dues
  - o No late fees on the \$92.50
    - Non-Financial/Reclaimed Sorors
      - If non-financial for one year, the \$385 becomes \$400 (included \$15 re-instatement fee)
      - If non-financial for two years or more, the \$385 becomes \$415 (included \$30 reinstatement fee)
- Full Year (to start the 2024 Calendar Year) Jan 1 Dec 31, 2024
  - Payable Jul 1 Sep 30, 2023: \$385 Regular or \$195 Lifetime Member
  - o Represents a full year of local and national dues
  - Late fees begin Oct 1, 2023
    - If non-financial for one year, the \$385 becomes \$400
    - If non-financial for two years or more, the \$385 becomes \$415


