Call to Order (quorum present) at 6:11 P.M. by President Blackmon

Officers

President Blackmon stated we had an outstanding convention and state of the region address by RD Barker indicates that as a region we are in good standing. We are waiting on official announcement regarding regional conference. President Blackmon stated she'd give a full report at the next executive board meeting. President Blackmon thanked those involved with bringing together the August Chapter retreat and our first chapter meeting will be in person on 9/9 at Austin Community College (ACC) Highland.

Financial Secretary Anita Daniels reminded us of the dues amount for the short year (\$92.50). Anita Daniels reported that she will collect dues in person at the retreat and the deadline to collect dues would be the executive board in September. Total collected May-August 15, 2023-\$27,534.15. Treasurer/Budget and Finance Deborah Shaw-Boatner reported the balances of the accounts and provided recommendations of an adjusted budget from the budget and finance committee due to



additional funds being collected. Beginning balance- \$141,149.56. Ending balance- \$104,801.63. Deborah Shaw Boatner moved that the report of adjustments from the budget and finance committee be accepted as presented. The motion carried with 22 for and 0 against. Five Point Thrust

Social Action presented by Co-Chair Veronica Johnson who led with the social action moment which dealt with voting and civic engagement as well as education and bill tracking. Additionally, the social action committee is asking that the chapter attend school board meetings and participate in voter registration day as well as social justice weekend. The committee brought forth a recommendation. Veronica Johnson moved that the school board meetings for Pflugerville, Hutto, Round Rock, Manor and Austin be added to the chapter's program calendar. After some discussion the motion passed 24 to 1. A reminder was given that the social action committee meets on the 2nd Tuesday at 6:30.

Standing Committees

Internal Audit presented by Sophia Williams reported that the findings from 4/1/2023-6/30/2023 (the 4th quarter report) find our chapter in good order.

Ways and Means presented by Alnita Foote gave us a history of the ADF foundation and the history of the house (including eh burning of the mortgage on 9/19/1993 and the directive from the National body to remove all symbols and letters from the house). The foundation has given more than \$209,000 in scholarships from 2001-2022. Ways and Means will partner with ADF for an event on 12/9 to give the gift of education with a \$30,000 goal.

Executive Committee met 8/14 at 7:00 P.M. with a quorum present and Kacey Hanson made the following motion: Move that we hold executive board meetings on the Tuesday before chapter meetings on zoom at 7:00 pm beginning the sorority year. The motion passed 23 to 3.
