TH ANNIVERSARY OF Brown v. Board of Topeka (1954)

The Brown v. Board of Education of Topeka, Kansas is arguably one of the most important cases of the 20th century. The Supreme Court decision legally struck down "separate but equal" practices set in place by the Plessy v. Ferguson case. The decision changed the course of education in America and resulted in expanded K-12 and postsecondary educational opportunities for African American students.

However, some would say that in recent years, there have been just as many challenges as triumphs related to HBCU funding, book bans, attacks on Critical Race Theory, rollbacks on affirmative action, dearth of teachers color and other critical issues.
